Parents	School response
Who comes back?	Year 6, year 1 and Ladybirds reception as well as the children we have had in
How many days?	Full time - 5 days / week
Can siblings come?	Not yet unless they have been in
Where will the children be?	In class bubbles of no more than 15 children Y6 split into 2 bubbles There will be just one group of Y2,3,4,5 who will be in one of their year group classes Children will know their bubble adults
My child likes me to drop them off	We have to be sensible and avoid as much contact as possible. Parents of YR, and Y1 as well Little Acorns will come at staggered times onto the KS1 playground, drop children and leave. Parents of Y2,3,4,5,6 will wait on playing field at a distance from each other for their slot. These parents will not come onto school site at drop off and collection time.
Is breakfast club running?	For those who have already applied and been coming
Who will my child be in contact with?	Their bubble of upto 15 children and 3 staff Children based at a distance with what they need
Does my child need to bring in their own sanitiser?	No, school has plenty of hand cleaner and soap
What are health and hygiene measures in school?	Hand washing, regular temperatures taken (infra red so quick and easy) Cleaning surfaces, taps, hall floor etc through the day. Doors open. Big clean each evening.
Will there be hot school lunches if children usually have them?	Yes - And can be ordered If packed lunch - bring as usual
What about uniform?	Yes and PE kit left at school
What about pencil cases?	No
If my child forgets something?	Bring to office as usual
Will children get homework?	Maybe
Will there be after school clubs?	Not this half term
Will Y6 get bikeability?	Maybe (not confirmed yet) so get practicing!!
What about trips?	None planned yet
What if someone gets COVID?	Their bubble will all go home to self isolate for 14 days
Will the pop up shop continue?	Yes for as long as we can fund
Will children at home get work?	Yes, parentmailed or pick up packs from office

Questions from pupils about the 1st June

Pupils	School response
How will I keep myself safe?	<p>Keep further apart from everyone than usual</p> <p>Move around class carefully - listen to adults</p> <p>Give space to people</p> <p>Use outside doors only to classes</p> <p>Have your things you need near to you</p> <p>Try and keep to the left if you are on a corridor</p> <p>YR will be rotated in small groups</p>
Will there be break and lunch break?	<p>Yes, but these will be at different times</p> <p>If you have hot lunch and need to wait - leave a gap</p> <p>You will be given an area to play in and staff will have suggested games eg. Tennis, hobby horse jumping course, rounders, 4 square volleyball, hoops, tyres etc</p> <p>No trim trail to start with</p>
Will I play with my friends?	<p>Yes, Friends in your bubble for now</p>
What lessons will there be?	<p>There is a usual timetable. Just like the one we always have.</p> <p>Also, each class has a nature, outdoor class slot and 2 sport slots to make sure everyone is outside a lot</p>
Will there be a trip?	<p>There are none planned at the moment</p>
What happens if I hurt myself?	<p>Staff will look after you. They may wear gloves and an apron too</p>
What about lunch?	<p>Lunches are staggered</p> <p>Packed lunch in classes</p> <p>Hot lunch in hall (YR) or under canopy (Y1)</p> <p>Y2,3,4,5,6 benches</p> <p>Break in allocated spaces</p>
I walk home (Y5/6)?	<p>This is fine. You will be taken to the road, crossed over and allowed to walk home.</p> <p>You must be safe and keep a distance on the way!!</p>
When will other children come back?	<p>We don't know yet.</p> <p>The government have said they wanted all primary children back this term.....</p> <p>If it is still small groups we have not got enough classes for everyone to be in groups of 15 and so would have to make a plan - not sure yet</p>
