Literacy activity	Read the story owl babies/ listen to retelling online. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TPQRiSTYFHo Who is your favourite character? Why?	Can you use your owl babies characters to retell the story of the owl babies? Can you remember what Bill says?	Can you find out 3 facts about an owl? What do they like to eat? Where do they live? Can you find a way to write your facts?	Can you label the picture of the owl? Use your sounds to try and write the sounds that you can hear. e.g- w for wing	can you find out some information about nocturnal animals and make a list of how many you can find.
Phonics	Please read and share books daily. Recap all sounds that are in bookbag. Practice fred talking and reading words in the blending book. Watch this clip- https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/reading-owl/find-a-book/read-write-inc-phonics--1/phonics-pure-sounds-video Use the sound cards to make and build words such as hat, cat, mad, sad, dog, pig etc				
Maths activity	Watch the video of numberblock 5. Can you clap 5 times? Can you jump 5 times? Can you find and count different amounts of 5 things eg- 5 shoes, 5 spoons etc.	Have a practice at writing the number 5. We sing the rhyme 'down and round and put on the hat'. Can you then find 5 things to match the number?	Can you go on a walk around the house or around your area and spot any numbers that you know? How many do you recognise? Where did you find them?	Can you draw or make the numberblocks from 1-5? Can you put them in the right order?	Log on to numbots and have a go at counting the different cogs and earning gold coins.
Creative and physical activities	Can you make the characters from the story owl babies? You could use card/ paper/ an old cereal box etc.	Can you collect some leaves and see if you can make them into a leaf owl? 	Can you design and make a nest for an owl? You could use twigs, straws, leaves etc.	Can you learn a song/ dance about an owl ?	Can you take part in the Joe Wicks workout?
