Catch up and be confident clubs - will run for 4 weeks this half term and again next half term for Y3, 4, 5 and 6. These are to help children's confidence with aspects of learning.

Sports day - will be linked to the Olympics and Paralympics. We have start our journey walking to Tokyo and managed 500 miles of the 3994 mile journey. We won't invite parents to sports day this year but we will take photos.

Transition - through the school will begin after half term. The children will spend time with their new teachers. Y6 will lead enterprise projects and new Year R (Ladybirds) children will also visit.
