**Football** - Children braved the weather on  $21^{st}$  and  $22^{nd}$  to take part in local tournaments. Very committed children played well.

Free School Meals - If you think you are entitled to free school meals (not universal infant free school meals) please call in the office for a form, if successful, you will be entitled to a free jumper or cardigan each year.

**Breakfast Club** - Please do not leave your children unaccompanied, breakfast club starts at 8am - we cannot be held responsible for children left before that time

Parking - When you park outside the school please ensure you are aware of children around your vehicle as many secondary children cross the road outside school. Please be really aware as you pull out to drive home to check children are not around your car. Do not use staff car park for parking or as a walk through as it is dangerous - thankyou.

**School crossing** - Please do use our crossing patrol, you can drop off older children so they can be crossed over the road safely.

Children in Need - YR organised a cake sale and collected donations from across the school. £228.21 was raised. Well done to Ladybirds!!

Poppies - Thank you for your poppy donations - we will let you know what was raised.

Coats – some children are not bringing a coat to school and as the temperature drops please ensure they have gloves and hats too – please put names in.

Parents Ofsted Questionnaires - Thankyou to parents who completed these with our school Governors on parent meet the teacher evenings. Parents had a couple of queries:

Every year group has a trolley full of **computers** or ipads. There is also access to coding resources as well as a wide range of technology and equipment.

Clubs run by staff are staff volunteering and we thank them for this. Ladybirds don't do clubs in the Autumn term as they have just started school and are likely to be quite tired after a day at school. They were invited to a film evening.

To support and reinforce learning we plan as many **trips** as we can afford and also seek grants to support travel and reduce cost to parents/carers.

After school club is working well. We welcome children on regular days as well as on an occasional day. Sessions are £6 to 4.30pm and £12 to 5.45pm.

Late Pickups - Please collect your children on time at the end of the day as teachers have meetings and training at the end of the day. We will place your child in the after school club which is  $\pounds 6$  if you are late.

End of the day - Please do not let children play on the equipment at the end of the day. Too often the children are not supervised. Maybe take the children onto the field opposite the school gates.

**Year 6 Residential** - Please ensure you return your signed consent form with a deposit as soon as possible, this enables us to book the activities for the trip.
