What works well at our school:

As a caring community school with high expectations this is a sample of what we are able to offer to our children:

- Dedicated and experienced teachers who develop positive relationships with all children to help them reach their full potential
- A fully inclusive school where all children are supported by caring staff to access the curriculum through adaptive teaching and make progress
- Trained Forest School and Beach School staff. (Forest School on site).
- Grants to fund trips such as the WWT and the Weald and Downland
- Opportunities for children to participate in a variety of sports off site.
- Theatre workshops and visits to Chichester Festival Theatre
- Links with West Sussex Music -musicians and orchestra's into school.
- Visiting music teachers offering music lessons to all children
- Access to a swimming pool (subsidised swimming as part of the curriculum)
- PE lessons taught by teachers and trained sports coaches
- Topic linked sleepovers and camping experiences on the school field.
