CHICKENS - Is anybody interested in feeding the chickens? This also gives you the chance to use the school field for picnics etc.. in the nice weather.

PARKING - Parking continues to be an issue near the school, please be aware Arun are patrolling and will be issuing tickets: Regulation 9 ticket will be issued directly and Regulation 10 will be tickets in the post.

SCHOOL LUNCHES - PARENTPAY - PARENTS WILL ORDER LUNCHES FOR THEIR CHILDREN - As you will be aware, Parentpay will be coming into action in April and you will need to order your children's school meals directly onto ParentPay, this will give you a chance to look at what food is on offer and to order exactly what your child would like to eat. An activation letter will be coming your way soon.

DOGS - Please if you bring your dog, onsite please make sure you come into the office and complete an up to date form and bring with you up to date immunisations and insurance policies.

FSM APPLICATIONS - If you think you may be entitled to Free School Meals come into the office enquire or apply online to see if you can get the additional help. If your child is eligible for Free School Meals, you may also be eligible to receive additional benefits such as food vouchers, hampers, holiday camp placements and a free cardigan or sweatshirt every year.

EMAILS AND PHONE NUMBERS - Please make sure your email addresses and phone numbers are correct at the school as a lot of our important communication is sent by email and text, if you need to update with us your phone number, email or your address etc ... pop into the office to complete the relevant form.

SCHOOL UNIFORM (from our prospectus) - one or two children are not wearing the correct uniform We believe school uniform encourages a sense of identity and pride. There is also a link between wearing a uniform and pupil attitude. For these reasons it is expected that all parents support the tradition that all children wear the Bersted Green school uniform which is:

- Grey/black trousers or skirt. (Trousers can be long or short).
- White polo shirt, bottle green school polo shirt, white school shirt or white blouse (Shirts/blouses can be long or short sleeved).
- Bottle green sweatshirt or cardigan with school logo (available from the school office) or bottle green sweatshirt or cardigan (available from supermarkets).
- White/grey/black socks or plain white/grey/black tights.
- A sensible pair of **black school shoes** are required for all pupils. (No trainers or boots, as these are not good for children's feet).

PE Kit need to be worn too - football kits should be saved for home -

- A school light blue T-shirt or white T-shirt (no football or fashion logos).
- Black or dark shorts.
- P.E. Tracksuits may be worn in cold weather for outdoor games.
- Plimsolls or trainers are required.

Please ensure that P.E. Kits are in school each day to minimize disruption to lessons and to avoid children becoming upset. Children are active daily and do at least 2 hours PE each week.

ALL ITEMS OF UNIFORM AND P.E. KIT MUST BE NAMED.

Governors: If you know a local business person or someone who may bring financial or marketing skills to our governing body or has a real interest in school governance in this community might you ask them to contact the school as we have a vacancy. A DBS would need to be applied for.
