If a child takes too much time off school, they will become categorised as 'PA' or persistently absent. (Attendance below 90% = persistent absence). This is very concerning!

School will reward classes each week with the best attendance and also children who improve their individual attendance.



**Staffing** - Mrs Burrows and Mrs Brookes are moving to work in nurseries after Easter. As always this is sad, but we congratulate them. We will rejig some staff members to support children's learning.


