This is a really big finale to the end of term with a lot happening.

All the children are working so hard. Some children have completed National tests this term: Y6 SATs in May, Y4 times table KS1 phonics. We are also using Y2 optional SATs papers to further inform teacher assessment; and YR end of year assessments

Y2 had fun with Chichester Harbour conservation at West Wittering and on the solar boat- making sandcastles and sticky pictures. The engine on the boat broke so Dormice didn't leave the pontoon so they will go on the boat in a couple of weeks.

Y1 enjoyed the Wildfowl and wetlands trust; Y4 go to Goodwood farm; Y6 have residential, swimming and harbour trip

Children have 'had a go' in their new classes and this went very well. They settled in quickly and have enjoyed their sessions with their new staff
